Educational philosophy

Riverbend Home School, located in Asheville, North Carolina, follows a classical, discussion-led curriculum with heavy primary-source reading and an annual independent project. This approach guides instruction across the school's subject areas of English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies/History, and World Language.

Credit policy

Riverbend Home School awards one credit for a full-year course of at least 150 contact hours, and half a credit for a semester-length course. To date, Sample Student has earned a total of 7 credits under this policy.

Graduation requirements

Riverbend Home School has set graduation requirements of 4 credits in English, 4 credits in Mathematics, 4 credits in Science with lab, 3 credits in Social Studies, and 3 credits in World Language. These requirements are being met through coursework in the school's designated subject areas of English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies/History, and World Language, overseen by Sample Parent, Parent / Home School Counselor.

Community and co-op context

Sample Student's education has been enriched through community involvement, including membership in the Blue Ridge Homeschool Co-op. Mathematics instruction has been supplemented with weekly tutoring by a retired engineer, and Spanish skills have been developed through conversation practice with a native-speaker tutor.

To the Admissions Committee:

I am Sample Parent, and I write this letter in my capacity as Parent and Home School Counselor at Riverbend Home School. I have taught Sample Student for all four years of high school and have supervised every course on their transcript, giving me a close and continuous view of their academic development.

Sample Student has completed Biology with Lab, Algebra I, World Literature, Chemistry with Lab, Geometry, US History, and Spanish III, and is currently in progress with Calculus and Physics with Lab. They have earned a total of 7 credits, with an unweighted grade point average of 3.76 and a weighted grade point average of 4.04. Sample Student works independently in mathematics and shows unusual persistence with long-form research, a strength demonstrated when they presented their watershed project to the county conservation board.

Beyond academics, Sample Student has volunteered 120 hours with the county conservation board, participated on their co-op debate team for three years, and worked part-time at a bicycle repair shop. Their dedication to research and public engagement was recognized when they took second place at the regional science fair in 2025.

I recommend Sample Student without reservation for a college that will let them keep working independently on long research projects.
